Why do PQRs?

- Foster state/regional communication and program implementation partnerships.
- Systematic check of foundations of state- and EPAimplemented NPDES programs.
- Promote program and permit improvements.
- Provide national perspective of different parts of the NPDES program.

What are PQRs?

- Review of NPDES program implementation on a 5year cycle
- PQR Components:
 - NPDES Program Review
 - NPDES "Core" Permit Review
 - National Topics
 - Regional Topics
 - PQR Reports

NPDES Program Review

- Covers:
 - Procedures
 - Permit issuance

- Program structure
- Challenges and initiatives

- Process:
 - Preliminary background questions supplied and answered prior to on-site visit
 - Initial interview during state visit using standard questions
- New: Status of Action Items from last PQR

NPDES "Core" Permit Review

• Covers:

- Components of individual permits common to most permits
- Primary focus is compliance with federal regulations
- Permit content, development, and administrative process
- Process:
 - Permit selection based on standard criteria 10 minimum
 - Desktop review using standard checklist
 - Review of administrative record during on-site visit
 - Clarifications from State permit writers on-site, as needed
- New: updated checklist

National Topics

- Covers:
 - Program implementation and permit components for selected topics.
 - FY12-17 cycle topics: nutrients, pesticides, pretreatment, and stormwater
- Process:
 - Program information gathered from state
 - Desktop review using standard checklist and procedures
- New: Three focused national topics
 - Permit controls for nutrients in non-TMDL waters
 - Effectiveness of POTW permits with food processor contributions
 - Small MS4 permit requirements

Regionally-Selected Topics

• Covers:

- Selected by Region individually for each state (e.g., CAFOS, mining) depending on regional priorities.
- Process:
 - No standard review tools
- New: Three focused national topics; optional regionally-selected topics.

PQR Reports

- Cover:
 - Documentation of PQR
 - Action items for addressing program deficiencies
 - Acknowledge program initiatives and strengths

• Process:

- Exit meeting held at conclusion of on-site visit to discuss initial findings with state
- Template used to present findings
- States have opportunity to review draft reports
- highest-level action items are tracked for resolution
- Once final, reports posted on EPA's website.

New: revised report format to improve readability

Who Participates in PQRs?

- States
 - Provide files and program information; host EPA review teams; review reports for factual errors.
- EPA Regions
 - Lead PQRs for authorized programs
 - Write PQR reports for authorized programs
- EPA Headquarters
 - Reviews programs implemented by EPA Regions
 - EPA HQ reviews pretreatment in states that have general program authorization but where EPA implements the pretreatment program
 - Manages process and assists Regions with reviews
 - Reviews reports before finalization

Frequent Findings from FY12-FY17 Cycle

- Applications
 - Applications sometimes submitted late without documentation that Director had approved an extension
 - Many were not technically complete.
- Standard Conditions
 - Some standard conditions were not as stringent as those in 122.41 and 122.42; some standard conditions were missing.

Documentation

- Many opportunities to improve limit documentation and antibacksliding/antidegradation analyses.
- Compliance Schedules documentation and justification

Innovative State Initiatives Observed in FY12-FY17 Cycle

- Online public notice for draft permits.
- Significant increase in the number of states that provide online public access for permit records.
- Efficient and effective use of permit and fact sheet templates.
- Watershed-based permitting.
- Tracking TMDL implementation in permits.
