Why ICIS Needs Updating


Integrated Compliance Information System (ICIS): data system that underpins many of the nation's compliance, monitoring, and enforcement programs for air and water

- ICIS-Air; ICIS-NPDES; and Federal Enforcement & Compliance
- Why modernize ICIS?
 - Better alignment with program needs
 - Support NPDES eReporting Rule
 - Improve usability
 - Reduce operations and maintenance costs
 - Improve data sharing and data quality

Vision for a Modernized Solution



The solution will be adaptable and efficiently meet the diverse and dynamic business needs of coregulators and their programs. Steps Taken for ConOps




- ✓ Established ICIS Modernization Board Charter
