



Ohio Background



- Water rich?
- We're new to water re-use



Cooper Farms

- Turkey processing facility
- Main employer for St. Henry
- 70% of villages water usage
- DAF pretreatment prior to discharging to sanitary sewer
- Water conservation efforts
 - 8.2 million gallons per year water savings since 2022



Village of St Henry

Water

- 10 Groundwater Wells
- 1.4 MGD design capacity
- 850,000 gpd average flow
- Draft aeration, sand filters, and chlorination

Wastewater

- Lagoon System
 - 4 lagoons totaling 44 acres
 - Floating aeration units
 - Ferric chloride addition for P removal
- 0.9 MGD capacity
- 2.4 MGD peak design flow




St Henry Capacity Issues

- ADDF of 0.87 MGD but treating 0.95 MGD, not operating as controlled discharge.
- Spring 2020 Village submitted NPDES modification and antideg request to expand to 1.2 MGD and continuous discharge.
- Approved TMDL for Coldwater Creek includes the assumption that St. Henry is a controlled discharge.
- Stream sampling completed in summer 2022 identified continued impairments



Alternative Solutions



Water re-use

- Need to treat to potable standards
 - Won't be used as potable
 - Ohio doesn't have standards

- Evaluate what other states have enacted
- Participate in national conversations


Goal is to have an Ohio Framework by end of 2025!
